The property benefits from double glazing and the radiators are heated via an open fire in the living room.

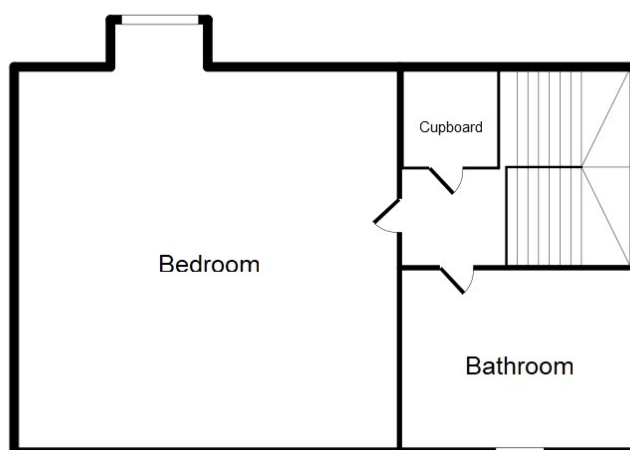
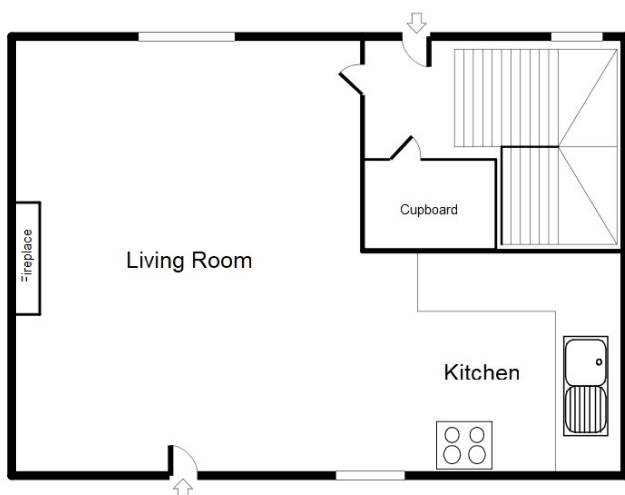
